## **ORDINANCE NO. 91**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6B OF ORDINANCE NO. 91 ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 4, 2018, AND TITLED "AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE LICENSING OF DOGS & CATS WITHIN THE CITY OF BROWNTON."

## The City Council of Brownton, Minnesota ordains:

- Section 1. Section 6b of Ordinance No. 91 adopted on September 4, 2018 and titled "An Ordinance Requiring the Licensing of Dogs & Cats Within the City of Brownton" is amended to read:
- Section 2. No person shall feed or allow the feeding of any stray cat or dog within the city.
  - 1. Exceptions. Veterinarians and persons who, acting within the scope of their employment with any governmental entity non-profit, or humane society has custody of or manages stray dogs and cats are not subject to the prohibitions of this section.
  - 2. Separate offenses. Each day a violation of this section is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate petty misdemeanor offense punishable up to \$300 per day a person is in violation.
- Section 3. This ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication.
